Welcome to the Reviewer’s Guide for Ulead® DVD PictureShow™2 -- Digital Camera Suite. The purpose of this Reviewer’s Guide is to provide highlights of this Suite as well as offer a brief step-by-step tour of its features and functions.

The Digital Camera Suite is the ideal companion for digital camera and scanner users, combining two powerful programs for managing photos and creating exciting multimedia slideshows. You can use your photos along with your CD or DVD burner to create exciting photo and multimedia slideshows that play on home DVD players. These slideshows feature outstanding picture quality (even from inexpensive digital cameras or scanned images) along with high quality audio, narration, video, and custom menu backgrounds.

DVD PictureShow 2 offers guided steps and a drag-and-drop interface to make assembling slideshows simple. As a complement, DVD PictureShow 2 includes Photo Explorer 8.0 which adds comprehensive features for acquiring, viewing, organizing, and adjusting digital images, as well as managing audio and video clips.

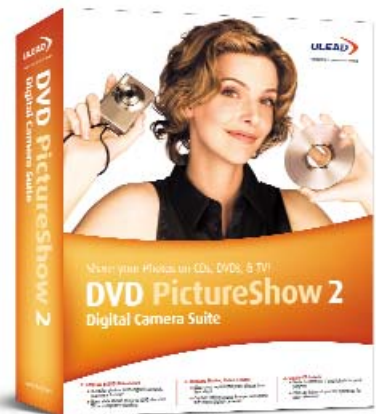

Market Situation

The rapid penetration of DVD players continues unabated. The Consumer Electronics Association reports that US year-to-date unit sales of DVD players are on the rise with DVD player sales up more than 41 percent over 2001, and reaching over 7 million units sold between January and August 2002. Recordable DVD and CD-RW device sales continue to be strong, with recordable CD drives standard on most new computers, and DVD-RW devices projected to grow through 2003. Dropping prices for blank media will also drive the sales of these devices.

Ulead DVD PictureShow 2 -- Digital Camera Suite addresses all of these trends. It offers a complete solution for organizing and enhancing photos, as well as bringing the enjoyment of digital photography into the living room by enabling customers to create custom photo slideshows that they can show on their TV sets using home DVD players.

The initial version of DVD PictureShow (released Q4 of 2001) tapped into the rapidly growing DVD market by offering easy-to-use features for creating custom photo slideshows. DVD PictureShow 2 -- Digital Camera Suite is the upgrade from the original version of DVD PictureShow. It also includes the latest version of Photo Explorer (v 8.0), a software tool for acquiring and organizing digital media. The combination of DVD PictureShow 2 with Photo Explorer 8 make DVD PictureShow 2 -- Digital Camera Suite the ideal package for digital camera owners who want to both organize and share their images

Target Customers

The Digital Camera Suite targets people who own digital cameras or scanners and want a complete set of tools to help them organize, enhance and share images in many different ways. They want a convenient and inexpensive way to use their DVD player to show photos and video on TV. They already have a computer system including a DVD-R/CD-R/RW device. Their goal is to quickly, easily and inexpensively organize and share their memories via print, e-mail, Web, disc and on TV.

Pricing and Availability

DVD PictureShow 2 will be available on Ulead's Web site (www.ulead.com) and on retail shelves and catalogs in North America starting in January 2003. The estimated street price for the box edition is US \$49.95. The electronic download is priced at US \$44.95. Ulead offers an upgrade to registered owners of a previous version of DVD PictureShow for US \$34.95 for the box edition and US \$29.95 for the electronic download.



Terms and Terminology

Project DVD PictureShow lets you build slideshows as part of a "project."

It not only lets you include slideshows that you make in DVD PictureShow, but also slideshows and video clips created in Photo Explorer.

Slideshow DVD PictureShow 2 lets you organize a sequence of photos like in traditional slideshows but it also lets you include music and narration.

Video (Slideshow) Though designed for importing video-based slideshows, this function lets you import any AVI, MPEG 1 & 2 files.

UES These initials stand for a Ulead (Photo) Explorer Show file: a slideshow which is created in Photo Explorer and can be imported and edited in DVD PictureShow.

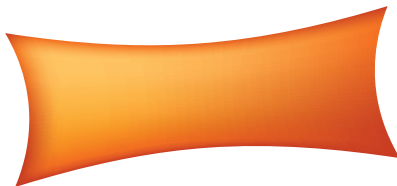

Pick and organize images, composing your own multimedia slideshows, complete with video, music, narration, transitions, custom backgrounds, titles, menu and image archive options. Guided steps and a user-friendly interface make it easy, and you can transfer your finished photo shows to VCD or DVD.



Ulead Photo Explorer 8.0 is well established as an easy-to-use digital media management tool. It has powerful tools for acquiring, viewing, organizing, adjusting, and sharing digital images, video clips, sound files, and more. Photo Explorer is the perfect companion for digital photographers, graphic artists, multimedia designers, Web designers or for those who just have a lot of digital images and other media.

The inclusion of Photo Explorer with DVD PictureShow positions the Digital Camera Suite as a complete solution, offering the best combination of features for organizing, enhancing, printing and creating photo slideshows for computers or on CD/DVD for TV viewing. Start Project

DVD PictureShow 2 enables you to create CD/DVD slideshows with a guided wizard-like workflow. In as few as three steps, you can burn your first DVD slideshow. When you open the program, you will see the *Start Project* step.

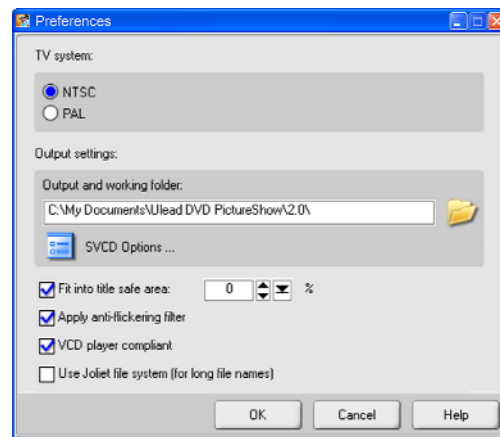
Starting

In this step, you choose a format for your slideshow. You can burn slideshows to CD or DVD media. As a general rule of thumb, choose VCD or SVCD if you have a CD burner and DVD if you have a DVD burner. You can burn the DVD format to a CD (aka miniDVD), but very few home DVD players will support it. Most DVD players will support VCD format, making this a great choice if you are using a CD burner. Once you have chosen a format, click *Next* to continue.

Setting Preferences

Before going to the *Next* step, you can first choose your Preferences (F6) by clicking on the *Check box* icon on the left bottom corner of the interface. In Preferences you can choose between NTSC and PAL formats (default is NTSC for North America). You can also choose a title-safe area which scales images and video to ensure edges are not lost when displayed on televisions. A setting of 12% for NTSC and 10% for PAL should suffice.

In the Preference box you can also specify a working folder, apply an anti-flickering filter for television viewing and specify VCD player compliance if you plan to view your disc on a dedicated VCD player.

Create Project

In the Create Project step you will have options to create photo slideshows, add video or import a slideshow from Photo Explorer 8.

1) New Slideshow

Clicking this button will open the interface to create a photo slideshow with images from your computer.

2) Add Video

If you have any video footage (including any multimedia slideshows on video) you can import these files into the project.

3) Add UES Slideshow

This lets you import a Photo Explorer 8 Slideshow file (UES) into your project, which you can edit later on.

4) Batch Collect

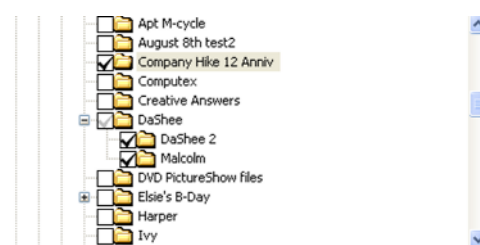
With this feature, you can pick and choose entire image folders, video files, or Photo Explorer slideshows and add them to your project at the same time without having to manually add each one.

5) Slideshow List Window

This window shows all the photo slideshows and video clips you have added to your project. You can add up to 99 slideshows to your project. Rearrange the order of your slideshows by dragging and dropping the slideshow thumbnails to the desired order in the *Slideshow list* Window. To edit a slideshow, just double click on the thumbnail.

6) Image List Window

This window displays all the photos that are included in your slideshow. By right clicking you can choose a particular image to be your slideshow thumbnail as well as rotate and delete images from the slideshow.



The Batch Collect feature lets you easily pick and choose photo folders to add to your slideshows with one click of the mouse.

Creating a Slideshow

New Slideshow

Once you choose the *New Slideshow* option, a new dialog box appears. By default, this step opens in simplified mode to let beginners get up to speed quickly.



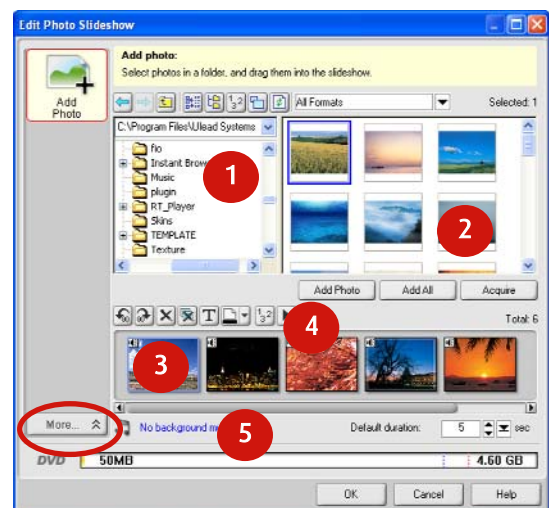
1. The Folder-Tree provides a Windows Explorer-like folder structure where you can pick a folder on your computer that contains the photos you want to add to your slideshow.

2. The File Window displays images from the chosen folder. Just double click or drag images to the *Slideshow Image List* pane to add images to your slideshow. You can also highlight multiple images and click the *Add Photo* button, or click *Add All* to add all images from that folder. Click *Acquire* to get photos directly from a digital camera or scanner.

3. Image List Pane shows the images currently in your slideshow. Drag to rearrange.

4. The Icon Bar provides options to rotate, remove, add text, add blank slides and rearrange slides.

5. Background Music can be added by clicking on the *Music Note Icon* on the bottom left. Delay can be set on the bottom right side just under the *Image list* pane.



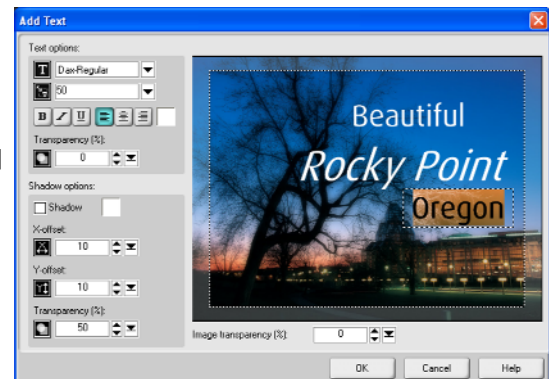

Add Text to Photos

By clicking on the *Text icon* on the *Icon Bar*, you activate the *Add text* dialog box. Just double click on the image to add text directly on the screen. Make a striking intro page or add useful information onto your image. You can change the font, size, shadow effects and even transparency.

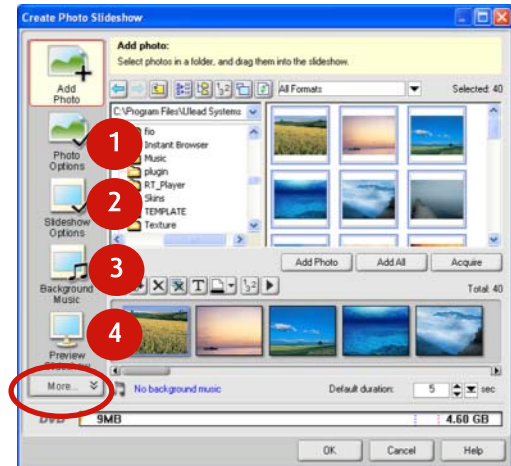

More Options

You can access options for greater control and creativity by clicking on the *More* button. This will instantly open up the left side of the interface to give you more creative options. Switch between steps by clicking the buttons at the left side of the dialog box. Steps include:

- 1. Photo Options:** Change duration of images, add or record voice narration, and add descriptions to photos.
- 2. Slideshow Options:** Add transitions, change background color and specify what text appears.
- 3. Background Music:** Add multiple music tracks.
- 4. Preview:** Instantly view your slideshow

Photo Options

Edit the properties of each individual photo in your slideshow such as the duration each image is shown. You can also add text captions and include sound annotation.

Clicking on an image in the image list will provide a larger preview below. You can type your text caption in the entry box below the preview window. Each image can have a different caption/description associated with it.

Add Voiceover Narration

Enhance your slideshow by adding your own narration to one or a group of images. Select *Enable sound annotation* and then *Recorded sound* to add narration to a photo, or click *Select sound file* to add an audio file (MP3, MPA, and WAV) to the image.

DVD PictureShow makes it easy to synchronize the duration of the sound annotation with the image by clicking *Same as sound annotation*.



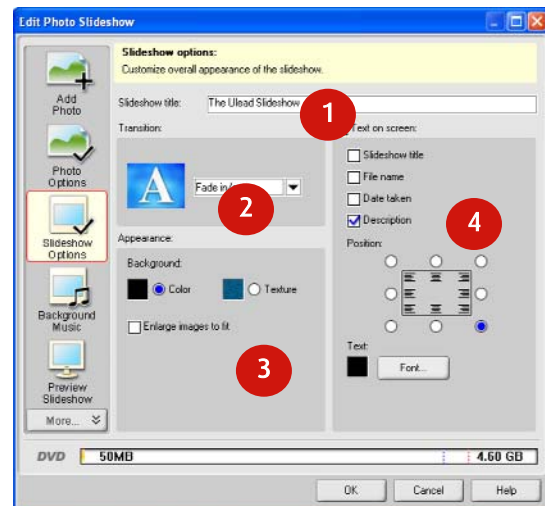

Slideshow Options

The *Slideshow options* step allows you to add transition effects and customize the overall appearance of the slideshow.

- 1. Slideshow Title:** Specify a descriptive name for the slideshow with a *Slideshow title*. It will appear on all slides.
- 2. Transitions:** Select from one of over 40 transition effects to apply between images in the slideshow.
- 3. Appearance:** Choose the style of your background and whether you want to *Enlarge images* to fit the entire screen.
- 4. Text on Screen:** This option will control what information will be displayed while the slideshow plays. You can choose the font and location of the information.



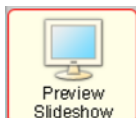
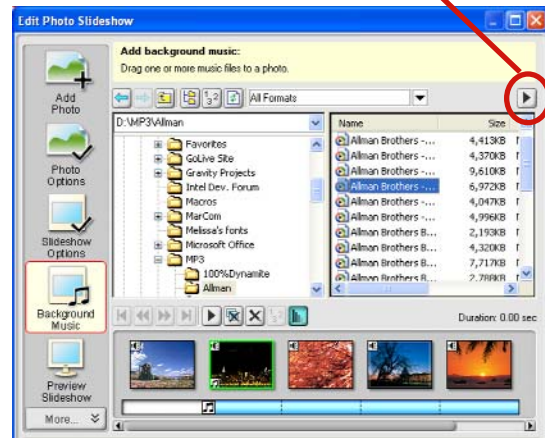
Background Music

The *Background Music* step lets you add single or multiple background music to the slideshow. Music added to the slideshow in the *Add Photo* step is treated as the initial background music in this step.

You can first *Preview music files*, then drag and drop music file(s) from the file window onto one of the images in the *Image list* window to make the selected music start playing at that particular image.

You can also *Auto fade-out* each music file, avoiding any abrupt music changes between songs.

Preview Slideshow

The *Preview Slideshow* step automatically displays a preview of the photo slideshow you are working on. Click the *Play/Pause* button underneath the *Preview* window to resume/pause the preview, or click *Stop* to end the preview.

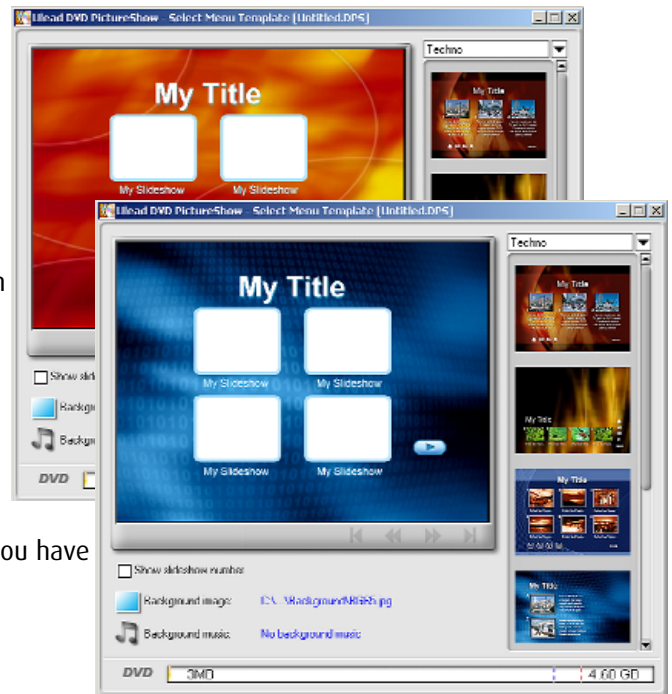

Creating Menus

After you have added all your slideshows and click *Next*, you will enter the *Menu* step. DVD PictureShow comes with many menu templates to help display your slideshows like in a Hollywood DVD. On the right side of the screen, DVD PictureShow provides several preset template layouts to set the theme of your menus. A drop-down menu offers you template collections in a variety of categories.

You can customize all the pages to have the same menu title, background image and background music, or you may customize each menu page differently. Click on *My Slideshow* near the slideshow thumbnails to enter descriptive text. If you have entered a slideshow title in the *Create/Edit Photo Slideshow* dialog box, you can still edit it here.

You can use your own custom backgrounds for the menu pages by clicking on the *Background image* icon and choosing an image. You can also add music to your menus by clicking *Background music*.



Output and Preview

DVD PictureShow lets you see your entire slideshow project, as well as the menu you created. It gives you an easy way to preview your show the way your viewers will see it on a VCD or DVD player.

In this step, you can also select additional items to include on your slideshow disc. DVD PictureShow allows you to embed the material from your slideshows onto your disc, including the original photo, video, sound, and project files (for re-editing). In addition, you can add copyright information, making DVD PictureShow ideal for archiving photos.



VCD Menu preview shows a different remote control. Play the slideshow by clicking the numeric button that corresponds to the number of the slideshow on the menu.

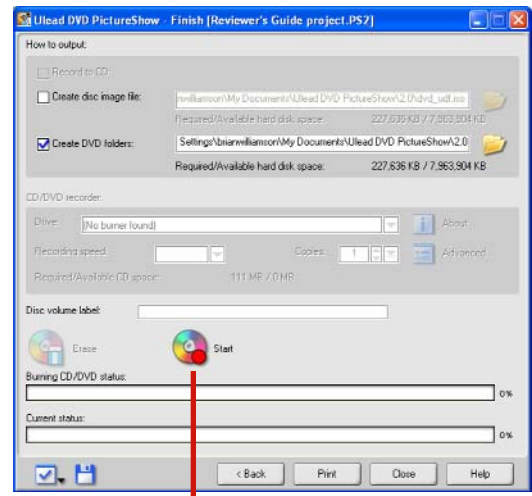
Burning to CD or DVD Drives

In this step you can determine your output options and the settings for the device you want to use to burn the slideshow disc.

Record to CD/DVD: Burns the DVD, SVCD or VCD slideshow to the disc.

Create disc image file: Creates the disc image file on your hard drive. This will make it easier and faster to burn additional copies in the future.

Create DVD folders: Creates a DVD file on your hard drive. This also allows you to view the file using DVD-Video player software in the computer.

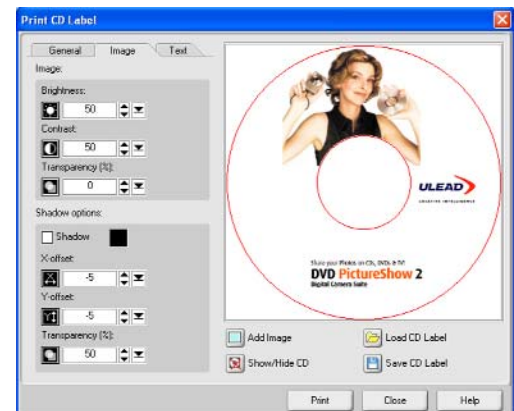

Printing CD Labels and Indexes

DVD PictureShow offers new printing features that let you present your slideshow CD/DVD with a complete photo index of your slideshow photos. You can print them to fit traditional paper sizes, or to fit into a CD case.

DVD PictureShow has CD printing tools that give you powerful features for adding text and multiple images to your CD labels.

What's New

Zip Folders

Zip folders are displayed as virtual folders in the Folder Tree, and can be manipulated just like any normal folder.

CD Catalogs

Photo Explorer scans a newly inserted CD and creates a CD thumbnail catalog added as a virtual folder in the Folder Tree. You can browse and search images from the CD catalog without inserting the disc into the CD-ROM drive. Insert the CD only when opening images.

Ratings for images

Rank images from your most favorite to the least favorite by setting a rating for each image (letting you categorize them without the need to move or rename the files).

Auto Slicing

Scan several photos at one time, and use the Auto slicing feature to automatically cut and save them as separate image files.

Improved slideshow features

More transition effects — Choose from new transition effects such as fade in/out, windmill, etc., and apply them to image slide shows.

Background music bar — Use the new music bar to synchronize background music with slides.

Burn slideshow CDs

Compose Photo Explorer (*.UES) slide shows using images, video and multiple audio files, and output them to CDs for PC viewing or export to DVD PictureShow 2 to burn DVD slideshows for TV viewing.

Acquire Images

Images can come from different sources. Photos taken with a digital still camera or video camera can be transferred to your computer. If you have a scanner, you can scan images directly to Photo Explorer. Photo Explorer also works seamlessly with memory card readers.

If you have a DV camcorder, PC camera or capture card, you can connect it to your computer and use Photo Explorer to capture video clips directly to your computer hard drive. Also capture single-frame or multiple-frame snapshots from a live video source. Later, you can trim, convert and optimize video clips.

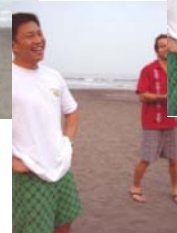

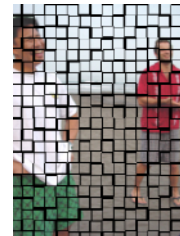

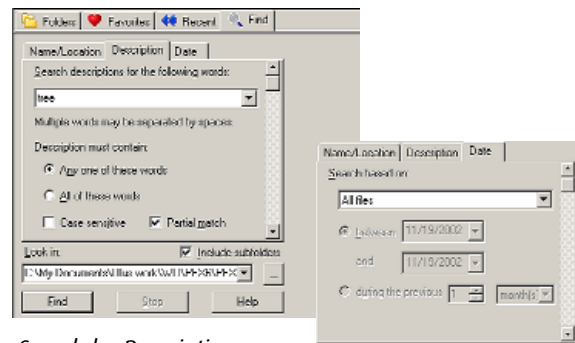

Media Organization Describe and Find

Photo Explorer 8 includes a new layout for letting users describe images with key words and find them with a search function.

The top left pane houses several tabs including Folder, Favorites, Recent and Find. You can toggle between these different modes easily and quickly. Under the *Find* tab you can use different parameters to search your images. The most basic way to search is by using the file name and folder. You can also search by description (which are the keywords you assign to your files). In addition, you can search by ratings (you can assigned an A, B, or C rating to your photos). This is great for earmarking images you want to work with that are located in different folders.

Finally you can search by date -- either by the date the photo was saved, or the date the photo was taken, if that information was recorded by the digital camera (in the EXIF metadata).

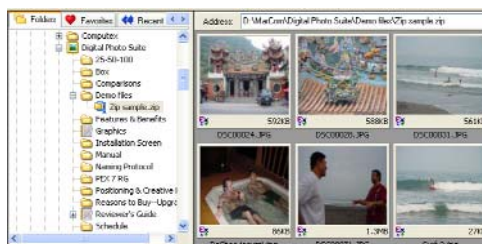

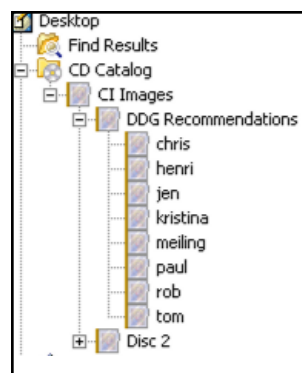
